Dear Auditionee.

Thank you for taking an interest in our third community project, Broadway classic, musical 'Fiddler on the Roof'.

After the huge success of 'Oliver!' and 'Whistle Down The Wind' at The Market Theatre in Ledbury, Our Star Theatre Company are delighted to be producing 'Fiddler on the Roof' at a brand-new venue, **Malvern Theatres**, from **24**th – **27**th **July 2024**.

Due to a tight rehearsal period, we need to adhere to a strict attendance at rehearsals, and will be implementing a five-strike policy. If you know you will be missing more than five rehearsals, then we're afraid that we will not be able to accept you on this occasion. Adult rehearsals will take place predominantly three times per week in **Ledbury** HR8, NOT Malvern. A **full rehearsal schedule** is included below.

The production will be directed and produced by Ben Mowbray, choreographed by Destiny Dawe and musically directed by Chris Corcoran.

Our Star Theatre Company is a Ledbury-based professional theatre company who tour original work to theatres on a national scale. After previous successes with our community musicals, we are determined to maintain the highest of standards with this show, and will be conducting the production with our usual professional approach.

For the audition, **everyone is required** to attend the Group Session from 2:30pm-3:30pm. At this audition, you will be asked to learn and perform a section of choreography from the show.

If you are also auditioning for a principal part, please pick one of the attached songs to learn (links and lyrics below). We expect to see a full-performance, with conscious choices being displayed in your piece.

Please note, the decision of the casting panel is final and should not be questioned. If you are offered a place in 'Fiddler on the Roof', you will be expected to be off-script as soon as blocking is complete.
